<p>Description</p>	<p>Known commonly as 'Woolly Bush', this Australian shrub-like tree is covered in fine, ferny silver grey/green foliage giving it a 'soft' appearance and soft to the touch. A great tree with brilliant red small flowers in amongst the foliage.</p>
