<b>Description</b>	<p>This tree is short and stout with interesting greenish bark. It produces white bell shaped flowers from Spring to early Summer amongst large leaves of varying shapes. It can become semi deciduous in early summer.</p>
<b>Foliage</b>	<p> Evergreen</p>

<b>Mature Size</b>	<p>8-10 x 10m</p>
