









Tree	 <p>Catalpa bignonioides INDIAN BEAN TREE</p>
Description	<p>This is a large attractive tree with a broad dome-shaped canopy and large long-stalked leaves. In summer it carries bell-shaped flowers in white, various pink shades, and soft apricot-orange, followed by clusters of long, pendulous, bean-like seed capsules, hence its common name.</p>

Mature Size	<p>15 x 12m</p>
Uses	<p>Perhaps tropical in appearance they make ideal subjects for parks, gardens, and avenue planting. They are very fast growing.</p>
Position & Soil	<p>Prefers sunny positions and is perfect for larger gardens. Whilst it prefers a rich moist soil, it can tolerate dry periods.</p>
