<p><b>Description</b></p>	<p>This is a smaller fastigate form of Ginkgo with lime-green summer foliage that is creased in appearance. In autumn, it presents with clear, yellow foliage. As a male clone of the species, its fruit does not carry an unpleasant scent. Only growing to 5 tall, this tree is both narrow and compact in form.</p>

<p><b>Position &amp; Soil</b></p>	<p>Prefers a temperate climate with cool to cold winters in full sun or part shade. Otherwise best to plant in a sheltered position, in aspects away from exposure to hot and dry northerly winds. Fertilise in late winter and mid-summer for optimum results.</p>
