















<p>Tree</p>	 <p>Leptospermum petersonii LEMON-SCENTED TEA TREE</p>
<p>Description</p>	<p>A beautiful Australian native tree with a shrubby habit. The new foliage is a copper/bronze colour. It has many small white flowers that decorate the tree in early summer. The leaves when crushed have a beautiful citrus scent.</p>
<p>Foliage</p>	<p> Evergreen</p>
<p>Form</p>	<p> Round</p>
<p>Mature Size</p>	<p>5 x 3m</p>
<p>Uses</p>	<p>Fantastic as a street tree because of its smaller growth and can also be used as an informal hedge because of its dense foliage. It also is a great bird attractant.</p>
<p>Position & Soil</p>	<p>Adaptable to most soils but prefers a well drained full sun position. Sites similar to coastal conditions are perfect. It's ideal for tough conditions e.g. drought conditions or poor soil.</p>
