<p>Description</p>	<p>This deciduous small tree with large green leaves that fall in autumn. This tree has magnificent large purple flowers shaped like a tulip. These appear before the leaves in late winter/spring and are a great contrast against the dark branches. The foliage is green and glossy appearing after the flowers.</p>
