















Tree	 <p>Olea europaea 'Correggiola' CORREGGIOLA OLIVE</p>
Description	<p>This tree has leather-like thin leaves which are green with silver undersides. Small delicate cream flowers are followed by green fruits turning purple-black when ripe. The fruit is edible.</p>
Foliage	<p> Evergreen</p>
Form	<p> Oval</p>
Mature Size	<p>6 x 3m</p>
Uses	<p>Great in a grove planting if room, otherwise plant it for contrast colour of foliage. This is an edible fruit tree.</p>
Position & Soil	<p>Olives flourish where there is good drainage and cool winters, and hot dry summers without humidity. Prefers a humus rich soil.</p>
