<b>Description</b>	A large sweet red to dark red cherry. This variety is self-pollinating.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Deciduous
<b>Form</b>	 Oval
<b>Mature Size</b>	5 x 2m
<b>Uses</b>	This is an excellent choice for backyards as it is a compact grower to approximately 4-5m tall. Mid-late season maturity. Good for eating fresh and for jams.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Prefer a sunny position in a humus rich soil. This is a high chill cherry so requires cold winters for satisfactory fruiting.
