<p>Description</p>	<p>An upright (fastigate) growing deciduous flowering Plum with dark purple/crimson foliage (sometimes incorrectly referred to as a cherry). Pale-pink flower buds turn to a profusion of single white blossom in early spring. Dark red-purple foliage turns bronze in autumn. This is a good tree if you are looking for contrast shape and colour in the garden.</p>
