<p>Description</p>	<p>This is a vigorous and fast-growing freestone peach variety. After a display of fragrant, pink blossoms in spring, mid-summer brings a heavy crop of medium-sized, almost fuzzless yellow-fleshed fruit that are yellow-skinned with a red blush. This is one of the most common and popular eating peaches on the market.</p>
