A slow-growing male Ginkgo with broad leaves that turn a stunning golden yellow in Autumn.

As a narrow growing variety, it is useful in gardens with limited space such as along driveways and footpaths.

Full sun / Part shade. Low water requirements once established. Best planted in a position sheltered from severe north-westerly sun and hot and dry winds
